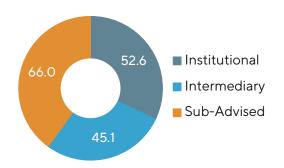

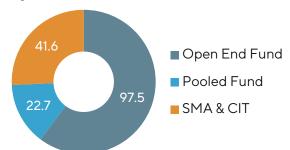

Performance Highlights – Last 1 Month (USD)

GQG Partners Emerging Markets Equity UCITS Fund underperformed the MSCI Emerging Markets (Net) by -1.34% net of fees. The portfolio had a net return of 2.84% versus the benchmark's 4.18% return.

By sector, the portfolio was helped on a relative basis by an underweight to Consumer Discretionary, and stock selection in Communication Services and Consumer Staples. Relative performance was negatively impacted by an underweight to Information Technology, stock selection in Industrials, and an overweight to Consumer Staples.

By country, the portfolio was helped on a relative basis by an underweight to China, stock selection in Taiwan, and an overweight to Argentina. Relative performance was negatively impacted by an underweight to South Korea, an overweight to the United States, and an underweight to Taiwan.

By company, top contributors to total return were Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Co., Ltd. and Grupo Financiero Galicia SA, contributing 1.29% and 0.29%, respectively. Top detractors Petroleo Brasileiro SA and Philip Morris International Inc. contributed -0.30% and -0.24%, respectively.

GQG Partners Emerging Markets Equity UCITS Fund underperformed the MSCI Emerging Markets (Net) by -6.76% net of fees. The portfolio had a net return of 6.30 % versus the benchmark's 13.06% return.

By sector, the portfolio was helped on a relative basis by stock selection in Utilities and Financials, and an underweight to Health Care. Relative performance was negatively impacted by an underweight to Information Technology, stock selection in Industrials, and an overweight to Consumer Staples.

By country, the portfolio was helped on a relative basis by stock selection in Taiwan, an overweight to Brazil, and an underweight to China. Relative performance was negatively impacted by an underweight to South Korea, and an overweight to India and the United States.

By company, top contributors to total return were Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Co., Ltd. and Centrais Eletricas Brasileiras SA-Eletrobras, contributing 2.16% and 0.64%, respectively. Top detractors Philip Morris International Inc. and ICICI Bank Limited contributed -0.32% and -0.30%, respectively.

By company, top contributors to total return were Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Co., Ltd. and Itau Unibanco Holding SA, contributing 3.71% and 1.53%, respectively. Top detractors Marvell Technology, Inc. and Colgate-Palmolive Company contributed -0.41% and -0.36%, respectively.

By company, top contributors to total return were Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Co., Ltd. and Itau Unibanco Holding SA, contributing 3.97% and 1.08%, respectively. Top detractors Adani Green Energy Ltd. and PT Bank Mandiri (Persero) Tbk contributed -0.77% and -0.72%, respectively.




